Loyalty. A feeling or attitude of devoted attachment and affection; steadfast love.

Servant-Leadership. "It begins with the natural feeling that one wants to serve, to serve first. Then conscious choice brings one to aspire to lead."- Robert K. Greenleaf

Kindness. Of a good or benevolent nature or disposition.

Meekness/Gentleness. A calm temper of mind, not easily provoked; power under control.

Humility. "Walking without wanting to be noticed." - Tony Beckett

Purity. Freedom from anything that debases, contaminates, pollutes.

Honesty. Free from deception, truthful, genuine, real, reputable, credible, marked by integrity, frank, upright, just, conscientious, honorable.

Self-Discipline/Self-Control. Discipline and training of oneself, usually for improvement of some nature.

Excellence. Of the highest or finest quality; exceptionally good of its kind.

Integrity. Soundness of moral character; the state of being whole, entire, or undiminished.

Perseverance. Steady persistence in a course of action; a purpose; a state in spite of difficulties, obstacles, or discouragement; intestinal fortitude.

Courage. The quality of mind or spirit that enables a person to face difficulty, danger, pain, etc. without fear; bravery.
