It shows us what to do (doctrine), what not to do (reproof), what to do when we did not do what we were supposed to do (correction), and tells us how to stay on the right track (instruction in righteousness)(II Tim 3:16).

Have Faith. Hebrews tells us that faith is having full confidence in the things for which we hope. Faith means being certain of the things that we cannot see.
